SUMMARY:	The temple door and <u>brazen altar</u> > a person opens their heart to enter into relationship with the Lord and leaves their former lifestyle of sin (at the altar) so their life can become a living sacrifice unto the Lord.	The brazen laver > the water baptism buries the old person and its corrupt ways, with more of a focus on the importance of being in unity with no divisions of belief between brethren, to stay focused on the cross, and to go from immaturity to maturity so there can be more room for the gifts of the Holy Spirit to operate.	The holy place doorway <u>thru the 2 pillars</u> > begin reading the Word of God, the law and the prophets versus the way of grace. Justification is by faith and not by law, in order to leave behind the works of the flesh and to grow in the maturity of the fruits of the Holy Spirit.	The table of showbread & <u>golden candlestick</u> > the daily bread of Bible reading and the Holy Spirit light of revelation, to help understand one's ordained destiny in walking with the Lord and growing in the ability of spiritual warfare, not by effort of the flesh but in partnership with God.	The golden altar of <u>incense</u> > a daily prayer life and a focus on living a Holy Spirit-led life, which is to put aside the things of the world in order to walk a spiritual path of the giving of oneself, resulting in receiving from On High an increased blessing and ability of grace with which to meet greater need in the world.	The veil > a barrier between the physical and spiritual worlds, also symbolizing the barriers between man and God to be mindful of, so that breakthroughs are possible when operating in higher realms of the Lord, even to the point of having the very nature of God, as a witness to the world.	Holy of holies & the ark <u>of the covenant</u> > in the glory realm with the glorious, fiery presence of God, when he comes at the last day to take his Bride home and puts down his enemies: "Sing ye to the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea."
