Column 1 - Adam was a type of resurrection from the dust. Enoch, 7th generation, was a type for the rapture event at the start of the 7th millennium, when he "ascended up".

Column 2 - Noah and family were a type for the rapture event, when they ascended in the ark high above mountains out of harm's way.

Column 3 - Moses was a type for both the resurrection and the rapture when Michael the archangel took Moses' body to glory.

Column 4 - Elijah was a type for the rapture as he ascended in a chariot of fire. Elisha typed the resurrection when his bones brought someone back to life.

Column 5 - Part 1 of the resurrection of the just (O.T. saints) with the resurrection of Jesus. Acts 24:15 "...there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust."

John 5:29 "And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation."

Column 6 - Part 2 of the resurrection of the just (N.T. saints), shortly before the 3-1/2 year Great Tribulation.

Column 7 - Part 3 of the resurrection of the just (tribulation saints), & rapture event at the start of the 7th millennium, followed 1000 years later by the resurrection of the unjust.
